Visa and residence permit	<p>EU/EEA students do not need visas to enter Hungary, but staying longer than 90 days, they will be required to register their places of residence. Non EU students should obtain "Resident Visa for study purposes from the Hungarian Embassy/Consulate in their home country</p>
